Players Code of Conduct

1. Each player to pay a full membership fee of £68 (in 2005 season this will be minus the social membership subscription initially, due to exceptional circumstances of no social facilities) before the 1st Saturday in June of the current season. After this date an additional £10 will be due.
2. Each player to arrive 1 hour before home games and arrive promptly at the departure time stated by the Captain for away games.
3. A named player to collect the match fees before the game commences. £8 match fees for senior players for Kent League games and £5 for junior players
4. Each player to undertake match day duties such as scoring, umpiring, collecting money, moving sight screens and covers, on a fair and delegated basis as decided by the captain of the day
5. Each player to be actively supporting the team whilst fielding and batting
6. Each player to notify the captain of his availability for the following weekend
7. If for a valid reason a cricketer can not play because of personal circumstances, he must notify the captain personally, 2 days in advance of the match that he is due to play in. It is not acceptable for any player to ‘cry off’ on the day that he is due to play for Hythe Cricket Club
8. All players to arrive at the game in a physical and mental condition whereby they are able to play cricket
9. All players to conduct themselves in a reasonable manner, on and off the field
10. Each senior player to stay for 1 drink after the game. If not able to do so they should inform the captain
